The Greater Atlanta Chapter of ASIS International in conjunction with Georgia State University's Georgia International Law Enforcement Exchange (GILEE), the Building Owners and Managers Association (BOMA), the U.S. Secret Service and the U.S. Attorney's Office is proud to announce that we will once again host and sponsor the third annual Law Enforcement/Private Sector Business Continuity summit.

This day-long and highly informative summit will once again address the latest international, national, regional and local threats to law enforcement, businesses, security and our local communities.

The session will be held on **Friday, October 7, 2011** at the Georgia Tech Research Institute Conference Center and will be FREE to all attendees. Registration will take place at 7:30 AM and the program will kick-off at 8:30 AM and last until approximately 4:00 PM. Breakfast and lunch will be included and POST, educational credits and ASIS re-certification points will be awarded.

This year's program will focus on three critical, relevant and impactful topics: the *active shooter*, the *"sovereign citizen"* and *predictive behavioral analysis*. Experts in each area will define the problem, its impact on law enforcement, property managers and private security and what the public and private sectors can do to address the consequences associated with each issue. Following these presentations, we will facilitate very interactive break-out sessions where a series of challenging scenarios will be presented to attendees who will then be required to discuss preventive, response, mitigation and post-event actions. Video and table top simulation methods will be used.

Please set aside October 7<sup>th</sup> to attend this important event and expect to receive more detailed information in the near future, including the name of our keynote speaker and a registration packet.
